WHAT IS THE MOOT?

The World Scout Moot is a world event that brings together Rovers and young leaders from different countries and regions. It promotes inter-cultural exchange, understanding, and friendship.

The Moot is designed for young adults with ages between 18 and 25 years old. It takes place every four years and is a unique and enriching experience.

The Moot features a wide range of activities and programs, including outdoor adventures, cultural exchanges, community service projects, and educational workshops. These activities are designed to promote personal growth, leadership development, and intercultural learning.

The Moot is a significant event in Scouting: it promotes the principles of the World Scout Movement, fosters international cooperation, and provides young adults with a unique and unforgettable experience. It also encourages participants to become active global citizens and ambassadors for peace and understanding.

HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE?

The first thing you need to do is to follow our website to start getting all the information about the Moot.



This is your first step to Engage!

The second thing you nedd to do is to seek information from your National Scout Organization about how you can participate in your contingent.

So, what are the different profiles you can have during the Moot?

PARTICIPANT INTERNATIONAL SERVICE TEAM – IST CONTINGENT MANAGEMENT TEAM – CMT

PARTICIPANT

If you were born between July 26, 1999 and July 25, 2007, you can register as a **Participant**. Once registered you will be allocated to a Patrol with up to 10 participants from different countries. A group of 5 Patrols will be a Tribe that will live the Moot experience together.

INTERNATIONAL SERVICE TEAM – IST CONTINGENT MANAGEMENT TEAM – CMT

If you were born before July 26, 1999, you can register as an **International Service Team** member ("IST") or as a **Contingent Management Team** member ("CMT").

Ratio between Participants and CMT is as follows:

NO. OF PARTICIPANTS	NO. OF CMT
1 – 99	Up to 3*
100 – 199	Up to 5
200 – 299	Up to 7
300 – 399	Up to 9
400 or more	Up to 10

*CMT and IST together cannot exceed the number of Participants in the contingent.





PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The first thing you will need to learn is how to say Lisboa (the portuguese way to say Lisbon).



If you are a CMT or if you are an IST selected to act as a Tribe Adviser, you need to be in Lisboa by July 23rd, 2025.

All the remaining ISTs and all the Participants are required to be in Lisboa by July 24th, 2025.

After the Opening Ceremony, which will take place in Lisboa on July 25th, Participants and Tribe Advisers will be heading to their respective Paths and all the remaining ISTs and CMTs will travel to the Main Camp.

HERE IS WHEN YOU START TO ENGAGE WITH OTHERS!

FROM JULY 25 TO JULY 29

All Participants will take the most out of the experience of living in a local community, Engaging with others and deep diving into our Portuguese culture in an international team.

JULY 30

During this day, your Tribe will be traveling to the Main Camp, where you'll be expected to bring all you have experienced in your Paths to share with all the other Participants. That same night, we'll have an opening ceremony in the Main Camp.

FROM JULY 31 TO AUGUST 2

You will have plenty of chances to know more about Portuguese traditions and crafts. Also, you will share your experiences and the flavours and sounds of your home country with everyone.

AUGUST 3

This will be our last day together. We will meet in the beautiful city of Porto where you will get to live the vibrant atmosphere of the people there and we will mix with the urban crossways of the city, its unique culture, and traditions.

THE PATH EXPERIENCE

We want to provide you the best Path experience in your Tribe. We also want to give Participants the opportunity to develop their skills in creating and managing a project with people from different countries.

For that, we will launch a call for projects regarding the Paths, including the necessary content to be in the projects (rules of procedure). Everyone can apply for this call with a project which will be reviewed by our **organizing team**.

To apply for a project, you need to set up a **Path Planning Team (PPT)**, formed by no more than 4 Participants, with a maximum of 2 from the same country.

After meeting all the requirements, the projects will be presented in our website for all Participants to select the Paths which will be then prepared by each of the PPTs.

Remember that you need to be a Participant to become a member of a PPT. If you register as IST, you can only participate in the Path if you are selected as a Tribe Adviser.

- Submission of Path projects: February 2024
- Selection of Paths: July 2024
- Preparation of Paths: from September 2024 to May 2025

The amounts are per person, and they are an estimate of the participation fee. Payment will be in euros (EUR).
