The 16th World Scout Moot 2025 starts on July 25th.

The long-awaited World Scout event, the 16th World Scout Moot, organized by the Scout Federation of Portugal, will begin on 25th July at Parque das Nações in Lisbon, with a grand opening ceremony at 9:00 a.m.

"Engage with us, Engage with Portugal". More than 7,500 young people between the ages of 18 and 25 from over 100 countries will come together to experience Portugal and participate in the 16th World Scout Moot.

During the first four days of the event, young people will have the opportunity to explore their own paths and discover Portugal, while building friendships with Scouts from other countries who share similar interests. **There are 118 different paths**, including outdoor activities, adventure sports, educational sessions, community and social impact projects, cultural activities, and much more.

On 30th July, all participants will head to Cortegaça, Ovar, where the main camp is located, to share their experiences and participate in activities with the entire group, making this event a truly global celebration of Scouting.

"In a time marked by global instability, conflict, climate crisis, and rising divisions, the World Scout Moot stands as a powerful antidote—offering young people a space for hope, unity, and action. This unique global gathering brings together thousands of Rover Scouts and volunteers from across the world to share in the adventure of a lifetime. The Scout Federation of Portugal

The Scout Federation of Portugal (FEP) is the entity that officially represents Portuguese Scouting within the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). Established in 1928, the FEP is the result of the union of two national associations: the Association of Scouts of Portugal (AEP), which is secular in nature, and the National Corps of Scouts – Portuguese Catholic Scouting (CNE), which is Catholic in inspiration.

The FEP does not engage in direct scouting activities with young people, functioning mainly as a platform for representation and coordination between the two founding associations. Based in Lisbon, the Portuguese Scout Federation ensures the active presence of Portuguese scouting on the international scene, promoting the values and principles of the scouting movement among similar organizations and global institutions.
