Closing Ceremony of the 16th World Scout Moot takes place on 3 August

To mark the successful conclusion of the 16th World Scout Moot, an official closing ceremony will be held to celebrate the achievements and shared experiences of participants from around the world. Media outlets are invited to attend the closing ceremony on Sunday, 3 August, at 5:00 PM at the Jardins do Palácio de Cristal in Porto.

Organised by the Scout Federation of Portugal (FEP) on behalf of the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM), the Moot has brought together thousands of young adults and volunteers from around the world for ten days of learning, community service, and international exchange across Portugal.

Since the official start of the gathering in Lisbon, 5,200 young adults have participated in "paths" created by their peers, immersing themselves in the vibrant culture, stunning landscapes, and welcoming spirit of Portugal's mainland and islands. Working in small, multicultural teams, they've bridged language and cultural gaps while tackling shared experiences like shopping, cooking, and collaborative exploration.

On 30 July, participants came together in the Main Camp of the event, in Mata do Buçaquinho, Ovar, to reflect on their experiences and prepare to return home with new perspectives and skills.

The next World Scout Moot will take place in Taiwan hosted by the Scouts of China in 2029.

The Scout Federation of Portugal (FEP) is the entity that officially represents Portuguese Scouting within the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). Established in 1928, the FEP is the result of the union of two national associations: the Association of Scouts of Portugal (AEP), which is secular in nature, and the National Corps of Scouts – Portuguese Catholic Scouting (CNE), which is Catholic in inspiration.

The FEP does not engage in direct Scouting activities with young people, functioning mainly as a platform for representation and coordination between the two founding associations.

Based in Lisbon, the Portuguese Scout Federation ensures the active presence of Portuguese Scouting at the international level, promoting the values and principles of the Scouting Movement among similar organisations and global institutions.
